Head lice

Unfortunately, parents have reported incidents of head lice. It is important that you do check your child's hair regularly and apply treatments appropriately to stop them spreading to other children in school. The only way to be sure someone has head lice is to find a live louse by combing their hair with a special fine-toothed comb. This is called detection combing. Conventional and electronic combs are available online and from pharmacies. Further advice can be found here.
