Friday 8th December


Reception and KS1 classes – We would like each class to bring in new toys/games/craft sets that would be appropriate for a child in the following age groups for our tombola prizes:

HELBY Visit us on Saturday 2nd December at the scout hut as we take part in Ho Ho Helsby.


We'll be running a teddy tombola there which always goes down a treat, so pop along and have a go – all proceeds will go to 'Friends of Hillside'.
