

Basic overview of planning sequence.

- 1. Group your pre-planning questions (e.g. into similar topics, remove duplicates).
- 2. Categorise the questions (allocate to a N.C. subject).
- 3. Review key national curriculum coverage for each subject.(refer to National Curriculum Objective Mapping doc.)
- 4. Refer to the age/level appropriate key skills.
- 5. Consider and match pre-planning for a subject alongside key skills.
- 6. Match questions to potential skills and think of resource / presentation ideas (these will form lessons).
- 7. Develop skills into a sequential series of lessons.
- 8. Write planning onto school planning girds including <u>pre-</u> <u>planning question</u>, <u>NC link</u>, activity, differentiation, intended outcome and <u>Key skill</u>.
- 9. Review lesson sequences to ensure balance, coverage and progression.
