Please be extra mindful of pedestrians when turning into Bates Lane. Our location makes this junction particularly dangerous as children will be walking to school both here at Hillside and to the High School. There was unfortunately an incident this week where a car turning into Bates Lane hit a High School pupil who was crossing the road. Thankfully the injuries were not serious but could so easily have been. If you are crossing Bates lane on foot to come to our school, please make sure you do so further up Bates Lane, where there is more visibility, rather than at the junction with Chester Road.

Reminder about Infant Free School Meals

I would like to explain how the Infant Free School Meals (IFSM) works. Schools receive a grant for Infant FSM based on those children who order a meal on census day. There are three census days a year January, May and October. If your child does not order a meal that day we do not receive grant funding for the whole year. Any subsequent meals ordered are then at a cost to the school (as we have received less grant funding). This year our funding was 83% and we have missed out on approximately £6,000 of Infant school meals income.

Our next census day is Thursday 19th January 2023. The theme is Enjoy the taste of the USA.

Please support our school funding by ordering a meal for your child on census day. Why not give it a try and if a little uncertain send something in as backup!'
