Well done Ava!

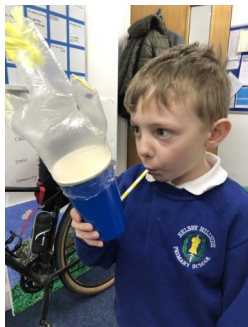


Y4 Tattenhall Residential
