**Reception to year 2** - We would like each class to bring in new items that would be appropriate for a child in the following age groups for our toy tombola prizes:

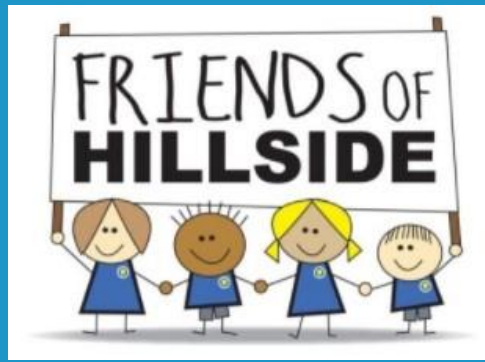
**Reception** - 5 to 7 years

## Class stalls

We are asking the parents of each class to take charge of running one stall. Parents in each class will need to organise their own prizes, set up before the fair and have volunteers for the duration of the fair. Any costs will be re-imbursed by friends of hillside but please try to keep these fairly low to maximise the money raised for school. If the class parents do not feel able to do this then unfortunately that stall will not be able to run. Suggested stalls for each class are as follows:

- Year 1 – refreshments (tea, coffee and soft drinks)
- Year 2 – Toy tombola
- Year 3 – lucky dip
- Year 4 – stocks (the stocks and teacher volunteers already arranged)
- Year 5 – cake stall
- Year 6 – tin can teachers

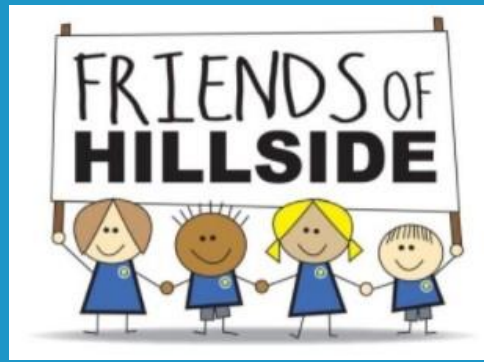
