


## Helsby Hillside Primary School – English EYFS Autumn 1 - Key Learning Overview

Communication and language	<p>Listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion</p> <p>Extend vocabulary, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words</p> <p>Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations</p> <p>Use talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events</p> <p>Introduce a storyline or narrative into play</p>
Reading	<p>Hear and say initial sound in words</p> <p>Link sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet</p> <p>Use vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by experience of books</p> <p>Hear and say the initial sound in words</p> <p>Segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together and know which letters represent some of them</p> <p>Begin to read words</p> <p>Enjoy an increasing range of books</p>
Writing	<p>Begin to break the flow of speech into words</p> <p>Hear and say the initial sound in words</p> <p>Link sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet</p> <p>Write labels and captions</p> <p>Write CVC words</p>
Handwriting	<p>By the end of the year pupils will/Will be able to:</p> <p>Use the correct pencil grip</p> <p>Be able to form most letters correctly</p>
