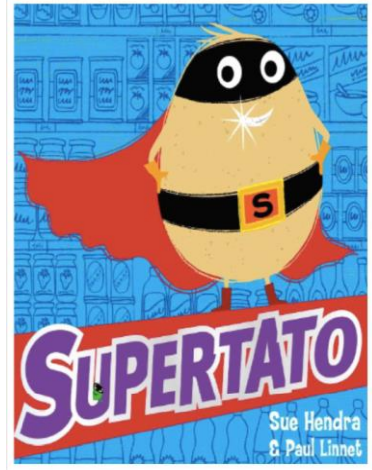

Communication and language	<p>Listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and responding with relevant comments, questions or actions</p> <p>Answer how and why questions in response to stories</p> <p>Express themselves effectively when speaking</p> <p>Develop narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events</p>
Reading	<p>Read and understand simple sentences</p> <p>Read some common irregular words</p> <p>Demonstrate understanding when talking to others about what they have read</p>
Writing	<p>Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match spoken sounds</p> <p>Spell some common irregular words</p> <p>Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others</p> <p>Write phonetically plausible words</p> <p>Use key features of narrative in own writing (EXC)</p> <p>Have an awareness of a capital letter and full stop when writing a simple sentence</p>
