

	Children will be able to:
Communication and language	Listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and responding with relevant comments, questions or actions Answer how and why questions in response to stories Express themselves effectively when speaking Develop narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events
Reading	Read and understand simple sentences Read some common irregular words Demonstrate understanding when talking to others about what they have read
Writing	Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match spoken sounds Spell some common irregular words Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others Write phonetically plausible words Use key features of narrative in own writing (EXC) Have an awareness of a capital letter and full stop when writing a simple sentence
