

	Children will be able to:
Communication and language	Maintain attention, concentrates and sit quietly during appropriate activity Listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion Extend vocabulary, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations Use talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events Introduce a storyline or narrative into play Develop narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events
Reading	Continue a rhyming string Hear and say initial sound in words Segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together and know which letters represent some of them Link sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet Enjoy an increasing range of books Read and understand simple sentences Read some common irregular words
Writing	Children will/Will be able to: Begin to break the flow of speech into words Write labels and captions Attempts to write short sentences in meaningful contexts Use phonic knowledge to write words in way which match their spoken sounds Spell some common irregular words
