- Provide each child with an artwork template, ask your fundraiser if you need more. **DO NOT PHOTOCOPY.**
- Read through our handy tips so that you can guide the children on what they can and cannot do.
- Have the children draw and create their artwork on the template. Check out the inspiration poster for ideas!
- Make sure that each child's design has their full name & class name in block capital letters at the top of the template. This should be completed by



- **8** Paper collage




#### Writing too close to the edge...




#### Use firm pressure with coloured pencils




#### Make sure artwork is central...
