We want to share with you the roles and responsibilities of Governors and clarify when it is appropriate for you to raise matter of concern with governors directly rather than class teacher or Mr Khan.

In practice, governing boards appoint the Headteacher and then delegate the day-to-day running of the school to them. The Governors, however, are still involved in strategic decisions, for example, we approve the Budget, the School Development Plan and we help appoint new Senior Leadership Team (SLT) staff. By working closely with the Headteacher, the Governing Body helps shape and monitor policy and practice.

There are 13 governors at Helsby Hillside Primary School including the Headteacher, six of whom are parents. These governors are elected by the other parents to serve for four years. Our governors come from a range of backgrounds and offer a range of expertise.

## Wear it Yellow Day

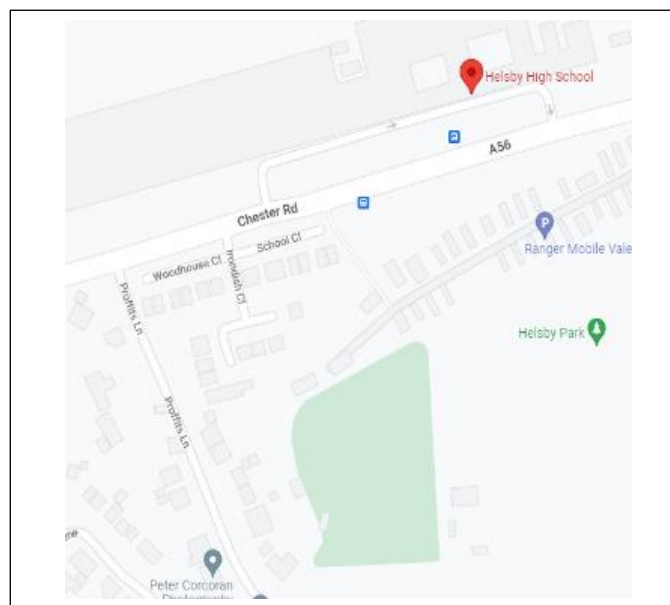

**Terms and Conditions**

The Junior Summer Swim Pass can be bought at any Brio Leisure Centre, simply pop in, and speak to a member of the reception team to get started. An adult aged 18 years or over will need to complete the promotion terms & conditions declaration form below. Available to buy from 1st July.

1. The Summer Swim Pass is available to all juniors under 18 years.
2. Your Summer Swim Pass can be purchased from 1 July and will be valid from Friday 22 July up until Friday 2 September 2022.
3. The pass will include unlimited swimming across all six Brio pools (reciprocal use) during casual swimming, lane swimming, family fun, wet & wild and fun & floats sessions at participating centres, subject to availability and programming - juniors with a Summer Swim Pass go free, parents pay the normal swim price.
4. Pre booking is advisable for sessions at Northgate Arena and can be booked by contacting the centre.
5. Facilities vary by centre and are subject to programming.
6. The pass can be purchased at any Brio Leisure Centre, not available online.
7. Payment is accepted in centre only, not online.
8. An adult aged 18 years or over will need to complete the Summer Swim Pass terms and conditions declaration below.
9. The Summer Swim Pass is a 6 week pass and is non-refundable and non-transferable.
10. The Brio Leisure pool admissions policy applies for every junior when swimming, visit <https://www.brioleisure.org/legals/pool-admission> to have a read so you know what to expect before juniors go for a dip.
