Usernames are firstnamesurname (all one-word lowercase) not your email address. If you are unsure of your username you can reset your account, the username will be on the email you receive.

Reception Grandparents' Day (Monday 3rd October) – The grandparents of our new reception children are invited to a special afternoon tea on Monday at 2pm where they can take part in some activities with their grandchildren and enjoy some tasty treats.
